

# Wells-next-the-Sea Accommodation List

## Privacy policy

This website is operated by Wells-next-the-Sea Accommodation List. We take your privacy very seriously therefore we urge you to read this policy very carefully because it contains important information about:

- who we are,
- how and why we collect, store, use and share personal information,
- your rights in relation to your personal information, and
- how to contact us and supervisory authorities in the event that you have a complaint.

### Who we are

Wells-next-the-Sea Accommodation List ('we' or 'us') (trading as Jim Parkinson) collect, use and are responsible for certain personal information about you. When we do so we are regulated under the General Data protection Regulations which apply across the European Union (including the United Kingdom) and we are responsible as 'controller' of that personal information for the purposes of those laws.

### The personal information we collect and use

#### a) Personal information you provide to us

We collect the following personal information that you provide to us:

Name & address, Business name, address & facilities, Telephone numbers, email, website and availability.

Some examples of when we collect this information include:

When completing an application for an entry on Wells-next-the-Sea Accommodation List. By telephone, email, SMS or in person.

## b) Personal information you provide about third parties

If you give us information about another person, you confirm that the other person has appointed you to act on their behalf and agreed that you:

shall consent on their behalf to the processing of their personal data;  
shall receive any data protection notices on their behalf; and  
shall consent on their behalf to the transfer of their personal data abroad.

## **How we use your personal information**

We collect information about our users for the following purposes:

To advertise their business on a printed list and on a web site detailing Bed & Breakfast and Self Catering properties in and around Wells-next-the-Sea, Norfolk, UK.

## **Who your information may be shared with**

We may share your information with:

Law enforcement agencies in connection with any investigation to help prevent unlawful activity

With the exception of storing your details on a secure server with Send in Blue, we will not share your personal information with any other 3rd parties.

## **Whether personal information has to be provided by you, and if so why**

We require your personal information in order to contact you to discuss your entry on the list.

## **How long your personal information will be kept**

We will hold your personal information for the following periods:

Business name, address and dates of entry on the list will be kept for UK tax purposes for 6 years. Full details you have supplied will be kept as long as your entry is active and deleted once cancelled.

These periods are no longer than necessary in each case.

## **Reasons we can collect and use your personal information**

We rely on the following as the lawful basis on which we collect and use your personal information:

consent

contract

## **Keeping your information secure**

We have appropriate security measures in place to prevent personal information from being accidentally lost, or used or accessed in an unauthorised way. We limit access to your personal information to those who have a genuine business need to know it. Those processing your information will do so only in an authorised manner and are subject to a duty of confidentiality.

We will also use technological and organisation measures to keep your information secure. These measures may include the following examples:

Your data is stored in a database protected by 2 passwords on a local computer and your name, business name & email is stored securely online with a mailing company Send in Blue.

We also have procedures in place to deal with any suspected data security breach. We will notify you and any applicable regulator of a suspected data security breach where we are legally required to do so.

Indeed, while we will use all reasonable efforts to secure your personal data, in using the site you acknowledge that the use of the internet is not entirely secure and for this reason we cannot guarantee the security or integrity of any personal data that are transferred from you or to you via the internet. If you have any particular concerns about your information, please contact us using the details below.

## **Transfers of your information out of the EEA**

With the exception of the advertisement you approve, we will not transfer your personal information outside of the EEA at any time.

## **Children and the validity of consent**

Where we obtain consent from any user we will take reasonable steps to ascertain whether the user is over 13 years of age and whether the child is sufficiently informed to give valid consent. If the user is not, parental consent will be required to provide consent for the processing of any personal information.

## What rights do you have?

Under the General Data Protection Regulation you have a number of important rights free of charge. In summary, those include rights to:

- fair processing of information and transparency over how we use your use personal information
- access to your personal information and to certain other supplementary information that this Privacy Notice is already designed to address
- require us to correct any mistakes in your information which we hold
- require the erasure of personal information concerning you in certain situations
- receive the personal information concerning you which you have provided to us, in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format and have the right to transmit those data to a third party in certain situations
- object at any time to processing of personal information concerning you for direct marketing
- object to decisions being taken by automated means which produce legal effects concerning you or similarly significantly affect you
- object in certain other situations to our continued processing of your personal information
- otherwise restrict our processing of your personal information in certain circumstances
- claim compensation for damages caused by our breach of any data protection laws

If you would like to exercise any of these rights please:

- let us know the information to which your request relates

From time to time we may also have other methods to unsubscribe (opt-out) from any direct marketing including for example, unsubscribe buttons or web links. If such are offered, please note that there may be some period after selecting to unsubscribe in which marketing may still be received while your request is being processed.

## **How to complain**

We hope that we can resolve any query or concern you raise about our use of your information.

The General Data Protection Regulation also gives you right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority, in particular in the European Union (or European Economic Area) state where you work, normally live or where any alleged infringement of data protection laws occurred.
